



Industrial Test Instructions

Please remember that once you start the Journey Test, you CANNOT quit. You will have to wait one full year or work 1,500 hours before you can test again.

- You have 8 hours to complete the Skills Test (all tasks) and the Written Test.
- The combined Tests have a value of 500 points.
400 points for the Skills Test
100 points for the Written Test
- You may work on the Skills & Written Tests in any order.
- Drawings, MSDS sheets & product data sheets are included in your Test packet.
- You may ask questions.
- Judges may choose not to answer your questions if the answer is part of your Test.
- Read & look over all written materials before you start your Test.
- Lunch will be from 12 noon until 12:30 pm.
- Your safety is our first concern. The Judges may stop you if they observe a dangerous situation.
- You must clean any brushes, pump & guns upon completion.

Cell Phones Must Be Turned Off During The Test

“You, as the person testing, are totally responsible for cleaning all brushes, roller frames, screens & buckets. This includes the conventional spray gun & pot, and the airless pump. Removing all masking from the mock-up is also your responsibility. Your lack of clean-up may affect your test score.”
